State Requirements for Participating in Texas Parent-Taught Driver's Ed

1. Make Sure You (the Parent or Guardian) are Registered:

- Download the DL-92 Request Form (you may do so at: http://teen.idrivesafely.com/dl-92-1.pdf)
- Mail the completed form to the Texas Department of Public Safety with a check or money order for \$20 at:

Texas DPS - License Issuance Bureau P.O. Box 149246 Austin, Texas 78714-9246

The Parent-Taught Driver Education Packet from the Texas DPS will arrive within 2-3 weeks notifying you that you have been approved as a Parent-Taught Instructor.

2. Have your child begin the I DRIVE SAFELY course

Once your child completes the first 6 hours of the course, they will receive a **6-Hour Permit Qualification Certificate (DE-964E)** via email. Be sure to add wecare@idrivesafely.com to your address book or safe sender list so our emails get to your inbox. If you do not receive the email within 48 hours, contact Customer Support at 800-990-2814. At this point, they should wait to continue with the course until they complete Step 3 below.

3. Go to the local DPS office to take the Texas Permit Exam and vision test, so your child can receive their Learner's Permit!

Bring the following to the DPS office for your child's written permit exam:

- □ The 6-Hour Permit Qualification Certificate (DE-964E)
- Proof of identity (such as a birth certificate)
- Social Security card
- Completed forms from the Parent-Taught Driver Education Packet:
 - Application for TX driver's license (DL-14A)
 - Parental Driver Education Affidavit (DL-90A)
 - □ Verification of Enrollment and Attendance (VOE) form
 - Classroom Instruction Record (DL-91A) for PTDE
- □ Proof of vehicle registration and insurance
- □ \$16 permit fee

Your child has 3 opportunities within 90 days to successfully pass these tests.

4. Continue the Parent-Taught Driver's Ed course and start behind-the-wheel instruction

Your child must continue with the I DRIVE SAFELY course for their permit to remain valid.

- □ Fill out the training logs provided in the DPS Parent-Taught Education Packet as behind-the-wheel training is completed
 - The logs document the amount of time the student spends in training

NOTE: 34 hours of documented behind-the-wheel training must be completed; 10 of those hours must be at night.

5. Complete the I DRIVE SAFELY course

Once your child successfully completes the course, they will automatically receive a Certificate of Completion via the shipping option they chose.

6. Report to the DPS for the Driver Exam

Your child must hold their learner's permit for a minimum of 6 months before they can take their driving exam and get their driver's license. When they're ready, make sure to bring the following:

- Learner's permit
- □ I DRIVE SAFELY Certificate of Completion
- Classroom and behind-the-wheel logs (DL-91A and DL-91B)
- Parental Driver Education Affidavit (DL-90A)
- □ Verification of Enrollment and Attendance (VOE)
- Proof of vehicle registration and insurance
- □ \$16 provisional license fee
